



BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING – MAY 23, 2023

CALHOUN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH MINUTES

1. The meeting was called to order by Kim Kramer, Chairperson, on May 23rd 2023, at 12:30 PM at Calhoun County Public Health – Training Room. Attending in person were: Carl Legore, Dave McClain, Barb Riley, Joleen Schmit, Shelly Schossow, Ann Lengeling, and Melissa Kinney. Attending virtually is Liz Peterson.
2. There were no public forum requests.
3. Motion to approve agenda by Legore, second by Lengeling, all ayes.
4. Motion to approve March 28, 2023, meeting minutes by McClain, second by Legore, all ayes.
5. The 2-month CCPH Report was provided, members compared and discussed figures.
6. The Communicable Disease Report was provided. Members discussed the increase in TB cases statewide.
7. Riley gave a workforce update stating that a family support worker and the homecare aide director will get an increased raise on July 1st. The Region 2 Wage and Benefit Survey was considered when making this decision.
8. Shelly Schossow presented on the SARS-CoV-2 Wastewater Surveillance Program explaining that the City of Rockwell City will collect water samples weekly and data will be collected to see if SARS is still circulating in the community.
9. Joleen Schmit reported on the Homemaker/Personal Cares Program Report, sharing a success story.
10. Riley gave an overview of the Local Public Health Systems Survey, outlining facts specific to Calhoun County.
11. Riley explained that there was a Mental Health Awareness Walk at the Rockwell City Town Square on Thursday, May 18th.
12. Ann Lengeling gave an update on the Community Health Needs Assessment. Members conversed about the best way to get the word out for a high rate of survey completion.
13. Riley presented the Crawford County Community Health Family Planning Report, sharing information specific to Calhoun County.
14. Riley explained that there will be a Public Information Officer Training and Exercise on June 7th and 9th at Stewart Memorial Community Hospital.
15. Riley provided the NIMS compliance policy. Members made a motion to approve the policy with changes discussed by Legore, second by Lengeling, all ayes.
16. The next meeting will be held Tuesday, July 25th, 2023, at Calhoun County Public Health Training Room with a ZOOM option available also.
17. Having completed the agenda, motion to adjourn at 1:40 PM by McClain, second by Legore, all ayes.
